Committee Report

Treasurer's Report - David Smith gave the Treasurer's report. He will transfer some of the money in checking to a T. Rowe Price investment account.

Controller's Report - Lee Lundy prepared the Society's tax returns on a pro forma basis. Maryland Orchid Society is still a tax-exempt non-profit organization with normal annual revenues below the threshold requiring filing of tax returns and therefore is not required to file a federal income tax return. After considering the situation, Lee determined not to file for 2006.

Auction - Bill Ellis has contacted suppliers for the fall auction. An e-mail notifying members of the auction will be sent prior to the auction. Aaron Webb will contact other orchid societies to notify them of our upcoming action.
